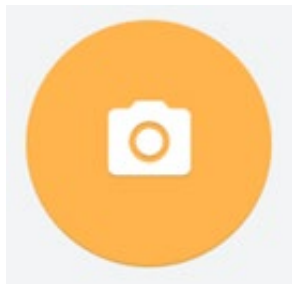

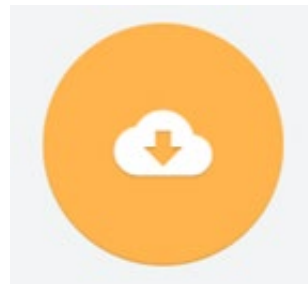

How it Works



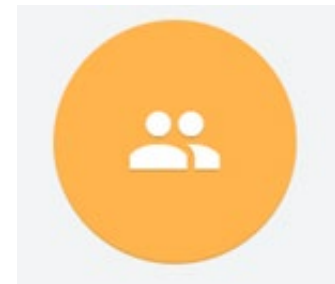
Add your picture or report

Your report informs decisions

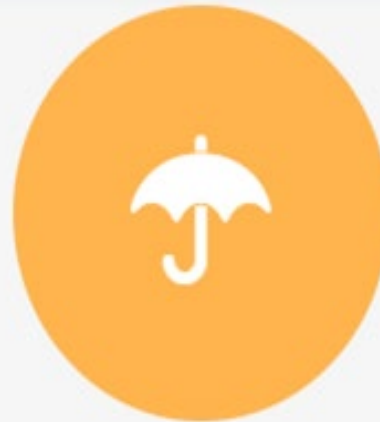
